Check out this Friesian, this one is in the colour of Liver Chestnut with a flaxen mane and tail. They come in two other colours... Grey as well as black with dark orange tips.

These beauties can be bought at New Hillcrest for 890 star coins and require NO reputation. You need to be at least 16 to get into Epona to purchase them You can also purchase similar FRIESIANS at Steve's Farm. Their mane is VERY beautiful as it is runs down the horse's neck and finishes above the horse's elbow. They also have a very special run which is SO cute!

New Hillcrest Stables need your help. Nathalie Moonriver requires a regular stable hand/groom. Experience essential. Nathalie pays well, your duties include but not limited to— Mucking out all 3 stables, filling the water trough, filling hay racks, brushing and picking out the horses hooves. 30js per job. On occasion helping to look after the horses “Lady” and “Rocky” who currently lives out. This role in the future might require you to help run the shop which is currently closed due to problems with her brother Ricky who resides at New Hillcrest.

The successful applicant must be level 16 or above and own a horse of their own. Transport links from Stables using the Blue trailers are available to use for a small fee thanks to the staff at Star Stable reducing the cost at the same time reducing their carbon foot print using only the best pixel petrol.

All applications need to be received by Friday 30th September 2016 to start work on Sunday 2nd October 2016.

DIY Livery available, for a one off fee of 25sc per move. Silverglade Equestrian Centre. Please speak with the Baroness if you are interested. Baroness lives on site with her Butler and various stable hands. Secure central location, with private access to the library, grape fields and cellar. On the odd occasion free grape juice testing is available. There is also an onsite café run by the Baroness' cousin and Courtney which offers hot food and nice high views. Also on site is many shops and local trade stalls to ensure a bargain or two.

There is also available for livery customers an outdoor arena at the back of the premises, as well as an indoor one for those dark winter nights or when you fancy some artificial lighting. One has show jumps and one is just empty for all your training / eventing needs. The empty one now also has a lovely few rows of seats so you can show off your latest moves. Accommodation is available for a small fee of the finest Star Coins, this includes a breakfast and a sunny picture. Also for a small fee of 7 sc a day Judy will care for your horses for you while you are away, this saves you needing to ask a friend to do them for you. This is just one of the many perks at being within this fine establishment.

There are several races on site and on a Friday you can enjoy the ability to earn a lot of money helping with the many dailies—This could even pay for your livery . This is one opportunity you do not want to miss out on.
