Hi can you please tell me how I can find out which server I am on as I have heard there are lots and you can change your server, so any help you could give would be wonderful. Also if you move to another server can you go back if you don't like it? I would be sad if I moved then couldn't go back if I didn't like it.

Hiya friend :) Thanks for your letter :D To find out what server you are on, log into Star Stable website, click "profile" - "Move Server" where it says "You are on this server" at the top, that is the one you are on currently. Any below "Servers in your region" are the ones you can change to. Your racing times don't go over till you log in if you change. You can move every 30 mins for free, however IF the server is full or locked for what ever reason then you would not be able to move back, you do have to tick a disclaimer before the move is successful. 9/10 it is fine, but there is always a risk you would be there till it gets opened again. Last year Star Stable had to lock "Wind Star" in America due to being too full, so it does happen on rare occasions. Friends will appear as offline if they are on a different server to you. Not every region / country has multiple servers as yet. UK only got Unicorn Forest September 2015 and Oz/Nz only have Firestar currently Good luck! Love and hugs, xx Nessie xx

Staff needed to help take cobwebs down and do a general clean up around Dews Farm, Forgotten Fields. Duties include but not limited to sweeping cobwebs, cleaning the well, stocking the barn with hay and straw, cleaning and tidying the tack room and feed room. Cleaning all the stables and buckets. This stable is for the travellers and we recently had a fire marshal around the premises and they were not happy with the amount of things lying around. Cobwebs if left can be a fire risk as they help the flames to spread so these must be taken down regularly. Mrs Pike will pay in fish and accommodation as unable to pay full wages due to the stables being out of action currently. Feel free to bring your horse here, you are able to do care on the stable yard front so your horse can be fully looked after while they roam free. This is a live in position, you would be required to stay in the cottage just the other side of the path. You will also be required to keep the cottage clean and tidy. On occasion people will need to stay with their horses as lots of people get lost in Forgotten Fields so always have your map to hand to help out these grockles. You will also be required to make sure they don't leave BBQ's going over night and that all the picnic stuff is cleared away to avoid rats and other vermin. Also please once a day go to "Pumpkin Cliff" and ship the pumpkins for Carin to display around GHV, they are in extra demand this time of year. If this role sounds just what you are looking for then please contact Mrs Pike directly and in person. References will be needed. Mrs Pike is located outside her lovely cottage between Jarlaheim and Epona fence boundary.

The stables have now been fully cleaned and disinfected. They are dry and ready to let out. Jorvik Stables are the oldest ones around and the most well known. They have many live in staff to ensure security. There are large metal gates which again add to the security. If a non authorised person sets foot through them it alerts an alarm which is linked to Johanna's phone. Also very close there is Jorviks finest security guard Gavin, the fact he misplaces his keys many times a week is irrelevant as it is code operated gate so no keys needed. This was done after Mayor Jack had to ask Ms Drake for a loan, we all know how that would have gone! Hope you can find a fix soon so I can go back and do the quest properly.


